

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19?



Recommendations by the CDC, Camden, Miller, & Morgan Counties

YOU TEST POSITIVE

Regardless of vaccination status
Stay home for 5 days



If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.



Continue to wear a well-fitting mask around others for 5 additional days.



If you have a fever, continue to stay home until it resolves.

YOUR CLOSE CONTACTS

Who have:

- Received a booster
- Been fully vaccinated with Pfizer or Moderna in the past 6 months
- Been fully vaccinated with J & J in the past 2 months



If you have no symptoms, wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days.



Get tested on day 5, if possible.

YOUR CLOSE CONTACTS

Who have:

- Not been vaccinated
- Received Pfizer or Moderna more than 6 months ago
- Received J & J more than 2 months ago



Stay home first 5 days after exposure.



Continue to wear a well-fitting mask around others for 5 additional days.



Get tested on day 5, if possible.
